### Your Step-by-Step "Registration and Get Ready for K" Process

---

1. Complete the registration packet enclosed.
2. Choose the type of kindergarten option you would like for your child; traditional or Spanish Immersion, full-day or half-day. There is a \$50.00 registration fee for the full-day fee-based program.
3. Plan to attend the Round-Up and Registration event at your home school or at Westwood for the Spanish Immersion Program. If you are unsure of which school is your "home school," based on your address, please call the district office at 763-785-5570 or visit [www.springlakeparkschools.org](http://www.springlakeparkschools.org).
4. Complete the registration packet and bring it to your Registration and Round-up event. You will also need to bring your child's original birth certificate (we will make a copy) and also your proof of address.
5. Register and complete Early Childhood Screening if you haven't done so already. (Screening is required by law.) Contact our Early Childhood Center at 763-785-5560 to learn more or to register for an upcoming screening date.
6. At your child's 5 year old checkup doctor appointment, ensure that immunizations are up-to-date. (Immunizations are required by law and no student will be able to start on the first day without having these completed.)

### Registration & Roundup Events

Plan to attend your home school Registration and Round-Up. If you are unable to attend on your designated night, you may visit another school for your child's initial kindergarten experience. Please note each roundup event is split into two sessions based on the alphabet and your child's last name. If possible please attend the appropriate session.

What happens at Roundup? *You will:*

- turn in registration materials
- pick up your kindergarten handbook
- visit classrooms with your future student
- go for a bus ride
- experience typical activities which will show you and your child what kindergarten is like!
